



Edward J. Faeder (Toxicologist)

Dr. Faeder is a valuable asset to the AEG team. As an independent expert Mr. Faeder oversees and directs a lot of the litigation cases AEG is retained to support. He is also an advisor for any health related issues.

Dr. Faeder has over thirty-four years' experience in environmental, health and safety management, and developing and conducting environmental and health-related research.

Dr. Faeder has been responsible for providing a wide range of health protection services to his clients.

He has worked for electric utility, school district, secondary metals, paper, and aerospace, pharmaceutical device research and manufacturing, pharmaceutical chemical stocks, oil refining, rubber tire, coal mining, health care and hospital, food production, and meat industry clients.

Dr. Faeder served as the consulting toxicologist for Saugus Union School District's indoor air quality program, performing a complete evaluation of the use of portable classrooms within that school district, resulting in the public presentation of more than 18 reports regarding the safety of those rooms. He has additionally assisted other school districts in California in areas relating to indoor air quality. He has operations and manufacturing analysis experience, and, has direct plant level experience in developing and implementing health and safety compliance programs. He has performed environmental, health and safety management analyses, health and safety facility audits, and chemical and toxicological analyses of specific work place and community chemical exposure concerns. He has assisted clients in developing and implementing programs specifically aimed at insuring U.S. OSHA, EPA, and other regulatory agency compliance, especially state agency compliance in California, and trained personnel in their implementation.

Dr. Faeder has also supplied litigation support to attorneys, both for plaintiffs and defendants, and has had direct responsibility for the development of the technical basis of litigation strategy in support of attorneys, corporate clients, and insurance carriers.

Dr. Faeder was previously Senior Vice President for The Jefferson Group, a Washington D.C.-based governmental relations consulting firm, and was responsible for developing a business base in the western United States. He developed an environmental, health and safety management auditing practice, while with that company.

Prior to joining The Jefferson Group, Dr. Faeder served as the first Director of Environmental Protection and Safety for the Lockheed Aeronautical Systems Company. He organized and established an environmental, health and safety organization at Lockheed that became a model in the aerospace industry.

Dr. Faeder dealt with major and complex environmental, health and safety challenges, including multimillion dollar negotiations and settlements with OSHA and EPA, during his tenure with Lockheed.

Previously, Dr. Faeder served as Director of Environmental and Health Sciences at ICF-Clement Western Operations, a national environmental consulting firm, where he was responsible for review and oversight of health-based risk assessments at a number of EPA Superfund sites. He spent eleven years at Southern California Edison Company managing Environmental Operations and Environmental Research Divisions, as well as five years with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency performing health effects research.

Dr. Faeder has written and presented numerous technical and management analysis papers concerning environmental issues, and served as an expert witness regarding chemical and biological exposures and their effects on people. He has considerable experience in the planning and conduct of health-based risk assessments for both environmentally contaminated general community and site exposures, and workplace exposures.

Dr. Faeder earned his Ph.D. in Biophysical Chemistry from Cornell University, and a B.A. in Chemistry from Columbia College. He did postdoctoral research in biochemistry at Duke University Medical Center. He has served on the faculty of the School of Public Health at UCLA as an Adjunct Associate Professor and has taught environmental toxicology in the University's extension program.

Dr. Faeder is a California Registered Environmental Assessor (00046), a Qualified Environmental Professional (05960083, Institute of Professional Environmental Practice), a Fellow of the American Institute of Chemists, and a Fellow of the American College of Forensic Examiners (3135).
